**NOTICE ON 14-DAY MANDATORY QUARANTINE PERIOD FOR TRAVELLERS
ARRIVING FROM BANGLADESH**

Please be informed that with immediate effect, the mandatory quarantine period at the dedicated quarantine centers for travellers arriving in Malaysia from certain countries, including **Bangladesh**, has been increased to **14 days**, due to Variant of Concern (VOC), including B.1.351 (colloquially known as South African COVID-19 variant). A **negative swab test result**, conducted within **72-hour** prior to departure, is also mandatory, regardless of your vaccination status.

This revised procedures apply to both **Malaysian**, as well as **non-Malaysian with special permission to enter Malaysia obtained through My Travel Pass and a valid entry Visa**. Letter of Undertaking and Indemnity (LOU) and Travel Notice are no longer required.

As per the ongoing practice, travellers are required to present upon arrival, among others, the proof of an advance payment made through **MySafeTravel** (<https://safetravel.myeg.com.my>) or **MyQR by MyEGMobileApp** for quarantine charges, COVID-19 screening tests and other related costs.

Travellers are also required to download, register and activate **MySejahtera**, which is an application developed by the Malaysian Government in managing the COVID-19 outbreak in the country.
